# From Fr Peter's Desk.....




Today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of our Lord. This event is recorded by the first three evangelists and implied also by John., but each has significant differences of detail. According to Mark, now usually considered the primary source for the events in the gospels, Christ came to hear John the Baptism and, like others received baptism at his hands. The implied motive seems to be the deep, sympathetic interest which Jesus felt in the work of John and the fitting character of such baptism as a public profession of moral integrity. The vision of the open heavens and the divine voice were the token of the Lord's mission as Messiah.

This feast also challenges us to reflect on our own baptism. And the responsibility we take on in baptising our children. In past days baptism was seen primarily as taking away original sin; now we see baptism in terms of the primary sacrament of initiation. In other words, this is the time that we become members of the church community. It is easy to see this in terms of responsibility but perhaps, like Jesus, we should see our own baptism as a gift from God and a challenge for us too, to mission in the world.
